- The percentage of patients reporting through the HCAHPS survey that they would definitely recommend the hospital
- Patient safety ranking based on 11 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' measures
  of infection and complication rates
- Low rates of early elective deliveries (between 0-1%)
- Baby-Friendly USA designation, a World Health Organization (WHO)/United Nations
   Children's Fund (UNICEF) initiative to support best practices for breast feeding education
   and counseling
- Level III and Level IV neonatal intensive care designations to provide comprehensive care for the most complex and critically ill newborns.

"Our award gives a woman the confidence that her choice of a hospital for her delivery will be the best in terms of quality care and patient safety for her and her baby. As the trend of women waiting longer to start their families continues, having the Women's Choice Award seal is especially important for older moms who face increased risk and need a top hospital to provide her care," says Passi.

Gibson Area Hospital is one of 426 award recipients representing the hospitals that have met the highest standards for obstetrics across the U.S.
