# **Check Committees You Wish To Serve On This Year**

 Annex Activities – Helping with manicures, popcorn, bingo, etc.
 Annex Cakes - Members take turns baking birthday cakes for the Annex residents once or twice a month.
 <u>Annex &amp; Hospital Christmas Decorations</u> - Members will put up and take down Christmas Trees and decorations in the Annex & Hospital.
 <u>Annex Gardens</u> - Throughout the spring, summer, and fall, members will plant and tend to the garden area at the Annex. GAH groundskeeper will water flowers weekly.
 <u>Annex Tray Favors</u> - Many groups in town contribute to this project. It may be necessary for a group of members to pitch in and create favors for the Annex Residents from time to time.
 Art Work - Children's artwork displayed in the M&S floor is gathered and hung by this committee.
 <u>Bloodmobile</u> - Members help make arrangements by calling volunteers to donate blood, set up appointments, and help plan and promote the donor days.
 <u>Bridge and Euchre Marathon</u> - These individuals play bridge with a partner throughout the year. A yearly donation of \$20 per player is donated to the Auxiliary to help with projects.
 <u>Gala Event</u> - This fundraiser for the Gibson Area Hospital Foundation needs Auxiliary volunteers in many areas to make this evening of fine food, auctions, and dancing a success. The Foundation donates money to the Auxiliary to help with their yearly projects.
 <u>Gift Shop</u> - The gift shop is a huge service to the hospital. Members are the workers and staff who man the cash register and stock the shelves.
 <b>Golf Outing</b> - Members will help with lunch, coordinating outings, tee prizes, and act as hosts for the day.
 <u>Historian/Scrapbook</u> - Members will memorialize the activities of the Auxiliary in scrapbooks. Plus, every 10 years we publish a history book about ourselves and the group will keep track of our activities.
 <u>Information Desk</u> - Info desk workers are liaisons between the patients and families and the various departments in the hospital. Training is available with a mandatory education annually.
 Needlecraft – Sewing, knitting, crocheting, etc.
 <u>Nominations</u> – This committee consists of two members of the board and three from the general membership. They are responsible for preparing a slate of nominees for officers.
 <u>Public Relations</u> - This committee will lead the way to promoting the activities of the Auxiliary and services of the hospital. Activities will include writing articles for the Vital Signs Newsletter, arranging photo ops and writing articles for local newspapers, and other activities to help promote GAH and the Auxiliary.
 <u>Recognition</u> - This committee will coordinate and distribute gifts for Doctors' Day (March 30 <sup>th</sup> ) and Nurses' Week (May).
 <u>Scholarships</u> - Each year the Auxiliary provides individual scholarships to those pursuing a healthcare related degree. We also administrate other scholarships for the Hospital Board. This group distributes applications, reviews them, and selects the winners.
<u>School Tour Guides</u> - Children from area schools tour the hospital each Spring and learn about the services it has to offer. Tour guides lead groups of 10 children and a chaperone to the various departments in the hospital to hear short speeches.
 <u>Showers of Flowers</u> - Once a year in February, the employees buy each other flowers to say thank you to one another for a job well done. Volunteers for this morning activity are needed to coordinate sales, wrap and deliver the flowers to the recipients.
 <u>Telephone Committee</u> - Members of this committee will call other members when volunteers are needed or when there is an uncoming event
