
Wondering why these words are written in red?




Time to explain the words that have been said

Butterflies fluttering in your turning begin to mount....




Remember being little? Mom and Dad love you so much




There is nothing like a loved ones touch....

Know, Stranger danger can approach... run away fast!








Mom and Dad always worry about their little ones




Like a lion with her cubs - leave alone!

Realizing that you are alone, is cause for alarm!




Hidden in plain sight you begin to shiver....



Hair on the back of your neck starts to guiver.












You can not make Stranger danger disappear with soap bubbles




A rain bow in the sky makes happy puddles.
